## Suggested Guideline for writing a Letter of Reference:

- 1. How long have you known the applicants?
- 2. What is your relationship with the applicants, i.e., friend, co-worker, etc.?
- 3. What characteristics do the applicants possess that will be assets in their parenting?
- 4. Include description of marital relationship.
- 5. Observations of applicants relating to children.

\*\* This is a guide for your convenience; however, please feel free to include any comments which you feel are pertinent.

<u>\*\*\*Please note:</u> In order to insure the integrity of any letter of reference it must be sent directly to the recipient without being forwarded by another party.

<u>The applicant should provide the originator/author of a letter of reference</u> with the NAME AND ADDRESS OF ALL RECIPIENTS. Recipients should include:

Note to Applicant: Four (4) written letters of reference are required. Two (2) from relatives NOT living in your household: One from husband's family and one from wife's family. Two (2) from NON-relatives

If you have worked with children in the past 5 years, one of these references must come from your employer.
